Guidelines & Procedures

July 1, 2020

Broadway Bulk Trash Pickup

The Town of Broadway offers monthly (starting the first Wednesday – Friday of the month) residential collection of bulk trash at curbside. Bulk trash are items inappropriate to place in the garbage truck for compacting and size restrictions. While Public Works staff will make every effort to follow the schedule noted above, excessive amounts of bulk trash, inclement weather, equipment failures and town observed holidays can delay bulk trash collection.

Bulk items should be left at curbside or at the town's right-of way. All bulk trash should remain in front of the property from which the waste originated. Please do not place bulk trash across the street from your residence. Please do not block the sidewalk with bulk trash. Bulk trash items must be placed at the curb by 7am on the scheduled Wednesday for pickup. All items must be arranged into separate piles for servicing.

Example items of bulk trash include:

- Furniture
- Mattresses & Box Springs
- Appliances
- Toilets
- Bicycles
- Metal
- Other like materials

Things to know:

- All paint cans must be empty and/or dried out with sand or kitty litter.
- Tires are not picked up.

Bulk trash pickup will be from occupied residences only- not from vacant lots or unoccupied properties.

Items that will not be collected with Bulk Trash:

- Construction & Demolition Debris
- Remodeling Material
- Bricks, Concrete
- Palettes
- Any Liquids
- Propane Tanks
- Rolls of carpet, linoleum, & padding

Broadway Yard Debris Pickup

The Town of Broadway offers monthly residential collection of yard debris at curbside. These items are picked up starting the first Wednesday – Friday of the month. While Public Works will make every effort to follow the schedule noted above, excessive amounts of yard debris, inclement weather, equipment failure and town observed holidays can delay yard debris collection. If your yard debris is not collected on the scheduled day, please allow us until the end of the week or the following work week to complete collection.

Yard debris should be left at curbside of the residence. All yard debris should remain in front of the property from which the waste originated. Yard debris must be placed at the curb by 7am on the scheduled Wednesday pickup day. All items must be arranged into separate piles for servicing.

Example items of yard waste include:

- Limbs (no longer than 6 feet in length)
- Plant or hedge clippings
- Shrubs
- Grass clippings (must be bagged)
- Leaves (must be bagged)

Things to know:

Yard debris should be left at curbside. *Please do not place yard debris across the street from your property.* Please do not block the sidewalk with yard debris. All yard debris must be placed at the curb by 7am on the first Wednesday of the month. All items must be arranged into separate piles for servicing.

Limbs should be no longer than 6 feet and 6 cubic yards per household.

Yard Debris pickup will be from occupied residences only- not from vacant lots or unoccupied properties.

Yard Debris cut by a Commercial/Professional contractor and/or commercial workmen will be the sole responsibility of the contractor to remove from the property. Note: Contract work is any work provided by a Commercial/Professional third party either paid or voluntary service.

Limbs should not be positioned into the street causing traffic or drainage interference.

Christmas Trees should be stripped of all decorations and other objects, including tinsel and nails, before leaving it at the curb. Trees with objects on them will not be picked up.

Items we cannot collect with Yard Waste:

- Debris cut by contractor and/or commercial workmen
- Rocks or Large stones
- Concrete
- Brick
- Dirt
- Metal
- Cross Ties
- Palettes

Household Garbage & Recycling

The Town of Broadway contracts with GFL (Waste Industries) to provide weekly curbside household garbage pickup services. The brown household trash cans are picked up every Wednesday. We recommend that the cans be rolled out to the curbside Tuesday night.

The Town of Broadway contracts with GFL (Waste Industries) to provide bi-weekly household recycling pickup services. The blue cans are used for recycling items only. The Town of Broadway is divided into two sections for recycling pickup.
